Data entry: suggested structure.

- ❖ First two characters= survey name abbreviation,
- ❖ 3<sup>rd</sup> character= number of the item within survey (dbl. digits—refer to 2<sup>nd</sup> digit),
- ❖ 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> characters= number of item within the instrument.
